A Few Things to Remember...

Player Guarantees

You will be asked to provide a final confirmation as to the number of participants 7 days prior to the day of your event. That number will be considered your minimum billable number. Your confirmed number of players must remain within 10% of the original number stated in the signed contract to secure the pricing of your event.

Deposits, Contracts, & Player Lists

A signed contract and \$500 deposit are required to secure a date for your golf event. The deposit is due upon signing your contract. The balance of your contract will be due the day of your event unless otherwise specified. We must receive a player list from you at least 3 days in advance of your event to ensure proper preparation for your event.

Food & Beverage Service

Brandermill Country Club will provide all food and beverage needs for your event. In rare circumstances, some charity events may be permitted to provide donated product if you have received prior authorization from the club. In these cases, a prearranged fee may be required and an addendum must be added to your contract.

Dress Code & Soft Spike Policy

Event guests at Brandermill Country Club will be expected to wear appropriate golf attire on the golf course and in the clubhouse. This includes collared golf shirts and excludes jeans, cut off shorts, and tee shirts. Brandermill Country Club also permits ONLY soft spikes or tennis shoes on the golf course. Please inform your guests of this in your promotional materials to ensure that they are informed in advance of your event.

Gratuities and Tax

All food & beverage service including on-course tabs will carry an applicable service charge of 21%. Unless you are tax exempt, the applicable Virginia sales tax will apply on the cart fee and all food & beverage products. Tax-exempt organizations will be required to provide the proof of exemption upon signing of your contract. We appreciate your cooperation.

Prizes & Contest

We gladly allow you to bring in merchandise and prizes for your event. We can also provide these items for you at a competitive price to ensure quick and easy planning for your event. A Checklist to Use to Help Plan A Perfect Event...

At Brandermill Country Club, we are committed to making your event the very best it can be. Your guests are asked to participate in lots of events throughout the year, and we want to be sure that yours is one that they won't ever want to miss!

One great recommendation we will make is to divide your player generation among several people. Getting 10 helpers to get 12 players each is a lot easier than asking one person to find 120 players. How smoothly your event will go will be determined largely by the plans you make in the months and weeks leading up to your event. Feel free to use this checklist, courtesy of your Brandermill Country Club Golf Professional; to be sure your event is perfect.

<u>Target Date</u>	<u>Responsibility to be Completed</u>
9 months in advance	Choose Brandermill Country Club, sign contract & mail deposit
5 months in advance	Print & distribute flyers and other promotional materials
3 months in advance	Start collecting prizes and requesting donations
2 months in advance	Order sponsor signs, banners, trophies, and prizes that must be logoed. Obtain Hole in One insurance and secure prizes for Hole in One contest
6 weeks in advance	Meet with the Brandermill Staff to discuss final details
4 weeks in advance	Finalize contest, games, and giveaways for your event
2 weeks in advance	Make final calls to confirm players for the event
1 week in advance	Forward final counts and rosters to Brandermill for golf and food
3 days in advance	Ensure that any changes to the roster have been forwarded to Brandermill to ensure the cart signs will be correct
Day of the Event	Sit back, relax, and enjoy the day. All the work is done!
